

OFFERS OF PAPERS

Abstracts of potential papers are now invited. These should be no longer than 500 words and they should be submitted electronically to l_meenan@imeche.org on or before Monday 3 October 2011. Authors will be advised of provisional acceptance of their papers by Monday 31 October 2011 and will be asked to provide complete draft manuscripts (also electronically) by Monday 16 January 2012. These manuscripts will be reviewed thoroughly and recommendations returned to the authors by Monday 2 April 2012. Final acceptance of the papers will be based on satisfactory responses to the recommendations and submission of final manuscripts (up to 4,000 words in length) by Friday 18 May 2012. The presenting author of each paper will be entitled to a substantial reduction in the registration fee and it is the Institution's policy that no speakers will be reimbursed any travel or accommodation expenses. All papers will be available on a memory stick and be accompanied by a published volume of abstracts available to all conference delegates. Authors are expected to attend the conference to present their work. In addition to the benefit of having a paper published in the conference proceedings, authors have the opportunity to submit their work to a journal. Work submitted must be an extension of the paper submitted to the conference and be completely original and innovative. Please note this is optional and not a requirement for conference papers.

Authors whose papers are accepted will be required to attend the conference and give a short presentation.
